



Guidelines & Safety Measures for Day Camp

Overview

The following is Guidelines and Safety protocols have been formulated based on the requirements given by the CDC and State of California Public Health Department. Superkids will continue to monitor all requirements given and adjust our protocols as needed. This is for our [Day Camp](#), there is a separate PDF for our classes.

Low Risk Start

Superkids is significantly lowering the number of students allowed to sign up for each day to 25% capacity. In doing so this will also allow for us to be able to limit the number of employees needed. Camp will only be offered 4 days of the week with a 15 camper limit each day.

The minimum age for camp has been changed to 6 years old. The age change will allow for the strict distancing and sanitizing rules through-out the day to be followed by campers.

The time for the camp day has been modified to a later time of 9:30am for:

- Cleaning prior to arrivals
- Sanitize stations to be set up around the facility
- Check In Station to be set up and give parents & campers time to safely distanced
- Distanced play stations in gym area to be set up for campers arrival

The time for pick up has been modified to an earlier time of 2:30pm for:

- Safely distanced pick up for parents and campers
- More time before our afternoon classes begin for a deep cleaning

As the risk factors are timely lifted we hope to be able slowly add more campers and get back to our full camp day hours. We will not do so without full permission.

Healthy Hygiene and Intensified Cleaning

All staff will be required to go through temperature checks and questionnaire of COVID -19 symptoms prior being able to enter to work each day and be required to wear a face mask. Sanitizing stations will be set up in multiple places around the facility for staff and campers to sanitize hands before and after different activities. Regular handwashing will be enforced for staff and campers.

Staff will clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces throughout the day including bathrooms. There will be limited sharing of objects such as toys, games and art supplies to the extent practicable. But where allowed, cleaning and disinfecting between uses.

Staff and campers will be educated and reminded to; stay distanced, wash and sanitize hands regularly, avoid contact with one's eyes, nose and mouth and cover coughs and sneezes.

Arrival and Departure for Parents & Campers

The limited number of campers allows for drop off and pick up to maintain social distancing. The following drop off requirements will be enforced:

- Only 1 adult will be allowed to check in camper. Adult must be wearing a face mask. If possible, please do not bring other siblings to check in that are not attending camp.
- There will be an outdoor check in station and one entrance with distanced space markers for the line.
- At the check in station, there will be a visual wellness check of all campers and temperature taken. Anyone with a signs of illness or temperatures of 100.4 degrees or higher will be not be permitted to stay. Anyone that feels sick with any symptoms or who have recently come in contact with a person of COVID-19 will not be permitted to stay.
- An outdoor washing station will be present for campers to wash/sanitize their hands before entering
- Once cleared, there will be one way for campers to come in and put away their belongings and enter the gym area, guided by a staff member. Adults will not be allowed to enter the gym area.

Pick Up Requirements will be enforced:

- Only 1 adult will be allowed to pick up and must be wearing a face mask.
- Line will be marked where to wait to pick up your camper in front of Exit door. Adult will not be permitted inside.

Camp Day Activity Safety

The activities and “free play” for camp have been modified for all campers to remain safe and distanced through-out the entire day.

- Our “free play” time will be in organized stations for one camper to play in at a time with a timed rotation. For Example, one camper will be allowed to have free time on the bars for a set time. They will be required to sanitize hands before and after each station.
- Group games will be adjusted to keep each camper distanced
- The older age group will allow for camp to be more gymnastics skills focused with more time for gymnastics through-out the day
- Arts & Crafts will be broken up into smaller groups to keep distanced and keep from sharing needing supplies.
- Snack and Lunch time will be done outside in a (fun!) picnic style. The outdoor area will have comfortable and covered ground seating in the shade.
- There will be no water slide offered this summer (bummer!) More outdoor time will be utilized in a safe and covered area.
